

You may nominate a citizen volunteer in one or more of the following award categories.



Angus and Bernice Read Volunteer Award

Presented to an individual whose volunteerism, leadership, commitment and actions have improved the quality of life for a large spectrum of the population in Cobourg. This individual will have a minimum of five years volunteer service.



Outstanding Youth

Presented to an individual who has displayed an outstanding volunteer contribution to the community and their school and who is nineteen years of age or younger as of December 31st of the year of nomination.



Outstanding Senior

Presented to an individual who has made an outstanding volunteer contribution to the community and who is sixty-five years of age or older as of December 31st of the year of nomination.



Bravery

Presented to an individual who has displayed courage and heroism, beyond the call of duty, in the face of danger in order to save others from harm. (This award will be given out when circumstances dictate, at the discretion of the Committee.)



Arts and Culture

Presented to an individual or group who has accomplished an outstanding achievement(s) in the community within the arts.



Sportsmanship

Presented to a coach, official or sports organizer who has shown outstanding leadership in contribution to Cobourg's sports and recreational community.



Layton Dodge Athletic

Presented to an athlete, who has contributed to Cobourg's athletic community in terms of ability, sportsmanship, participation and leadership.



Environmental

Presented to an individual or group who has made a significant contribution to conserve, protect, restore, maintain, improve, enhance or promote a healthy environment.



Heritage

Presented to an individual or group who has demonstrated an outstanding contribution to the conservation and/or promotion of the Town's cultural heritage resources.



Lloyd C. Stinson Memorial Award for Community Service

Presented to a resident of Cobourg who has performed outstanding charitable works to those in need, the aged, youth or those living with disabilities.



Distinguished Civic Awards

These recognitions differ from the preceding awards. They recognize specific contributions made during the past year and, may be awarded to groups as well as individuals.

Nomination for a Distinguished Civic Award does not exclude the recipient from nomination for one of the individual awards listed above.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION?

- Those who have volunteered their time and talents, or have displayed exceptional dedication to the enrichment of the community.
- Recipients must reside or operate a business within the Town of Cobourg. However, the selection committee may choose to honour non-Cobourg residents who have demonstrated a strong commitment to volunteerism in our Town.
- Paid professionals are NOT eligible to be nominated.
- Service Clubs do NOT qualify to receive these awards. However, individual service club members are eligible to be nominated.
- Employees of the Town of Cobourg are NOT eligible for nominations recognizing contributions made while performing their duties.
