ADAM BUREAU ANNOUNCES CANDIDACY FOR COBOURG TOWN COUNCIL

Cobourg, Ontario, Canada - May 1, 2018 - Adam Bureau, local entrepreneur and Board Chair of the Cobourg Downtown Business Improvement Area (DBIA), is pleased to announce his candidacy for Councillor in the 2018 Town of Cobourg municipal election.

"I am running for Councillor as I see this role to be a natural progression from my past volunteer and professional work," says candidate Adam Bureau. "Community involvement is something I value deeply, and it is important to me that I continue to play a positive role in strengthening our town and neighbourhoods."

A downtown Cobourg business owner for more than 10 years, Bureau started his first business at the age of eighteen. Since then, he has moved beyond his role as a business owner to become a volunteer and advocate for local business, revitalization and community improvements.

In 2015, he joined the Cobourg DBIA and was later appointed as the Chair of the Board of Management. In his current position, he is responsible for leading the organization and developing partnerships with Town committees to support the DBIA mandate. Bureau also sits as a member of the Downtown Coalition Advisory Committee, which is responsible for overseeing the execution of the Town of Cobourg Downtown Vitalization Action Plan.

Recently, Bureau also supported Max's Big Ride, which travelled through Cobourg in the summer of 2017 to raise awareness about Duchenne muscular dystrophy, and Pride Northumberland, a newly formed committee dedicated to raising awareness and education about the LGBT community. His latest endeavour, the Safe and Inclusive Streets Strategy with the Cobourg Police Service, identifies steps that the community can take to build a safer, more inclusive community for all who live, work, play, study or invest here.

Bureau has been married to his high school sweetheart, Wendy, for more than 20 years and together, they have three daughters Kayla, Brianna and Chantelle. As a family, they also have dedicated more than 12 years to foster parenting.

As an active member in a variety of volunteer and professional advocacy positions, Bureau would like to take the next step in community building by offering a new perspective to Council. The open-door policy Bureau promotes in his home and business, would translate into his role as Councillor. Bureau offers the Town of Cobourg accessibility, transparency and accountability, and is asking for your support.
